This is slapstick at the highest of levels, the kind of comedy where the laughter gets stuck in your throat. Dobelli describes with intense realism and subtle powers of observation the various stages of this life reorientation process – a roller-coaster ride between resignation and furious optimism – which ultimately takes an unexpected and personal turn.
