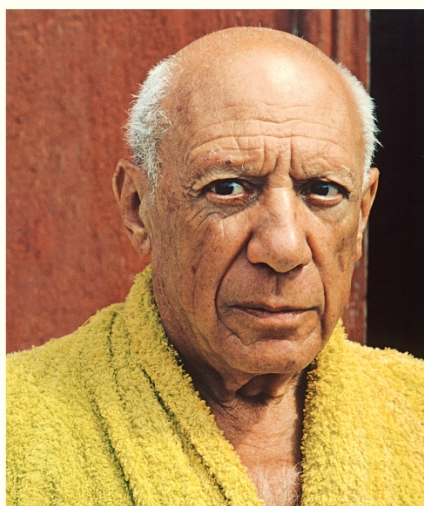

When Picasso meets hairdresser Eugenio Arias in 1947, they develop a deep relationship.

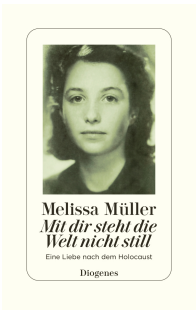

Monika Czernin, born in Klagenfurt in 1965, is a renowned international filmmaker and author. Her books about central figures and watershed moments in European history are best-sellers in Germany and Austria. Aside from *Picasso's Hairdresser*, Monika Czernin and Melissa Müller have worked together on several documentary films.



Melissa Müller, born in Vienna, is an author, scriptwriter and journalist. Her book *Anne Frank: The Biography* has been translated into more than 25 languages, and the film adaptation has garnered multiple Emmys. *Until the Final Hour: Hitler's Last Secretary*, co-written with Traudl Junge, was on the Spiegel bestseller list for over a year, and led to the Oscar-nominated film *Downfall*. She published *Picasso's Hairdresser: The Story of a Friendship*, a collaboration with Monika Czernin, with Diogenes in 2023.
