


**Charles Lewinsky**



Charles Lewinsky, born in Zurich in 1946, has been a freelance writer since 1980. He won international renown with his novel *Melnitz*, which was awarded numerous prizes, including the French »Prix du meilleur livre étranger«. His novel *Halfbeard* was nominated for both the »Swiss Book Prize« and the »German Book Prize«. Charles Lewinsky lives in Vereux (France) in summer, and in Zurich in winter.
