

The themes of Paul Flora's brilliant descriptions include subjects and personalities such as Charlie Chaplin, Saul Steinberg, Alfred Kubin, Kurt Moldovan, Fritz von Herzmanovsky-Orlando, venerable Austrians, authentic Viennese, original Tyroleans and seductive Venetians, adventurers, demons and monsters, monarchs and courtiers, go-getters, heroes and sea battles, art, caricatures and the cinema – a collection from Flora's world previously known to us only through his drawings: cheerful yet melancholy revelations, accompanied by an excellent biographical text.

Paul Flora was born in Glurns in Austria on 6 June 1922 and died 15 May 2009 in Innsbruck. He started working for the Munich *'Neue Zeitung'* in 1949, and in 1957 he became the political caricaturist of the Hamburg newspaper *'Die Zeit'*. He drew over 3500 political caricatures in fourteen years, as well as doing innumerable *'free'* drawings which have been shown in collections all over the world.
