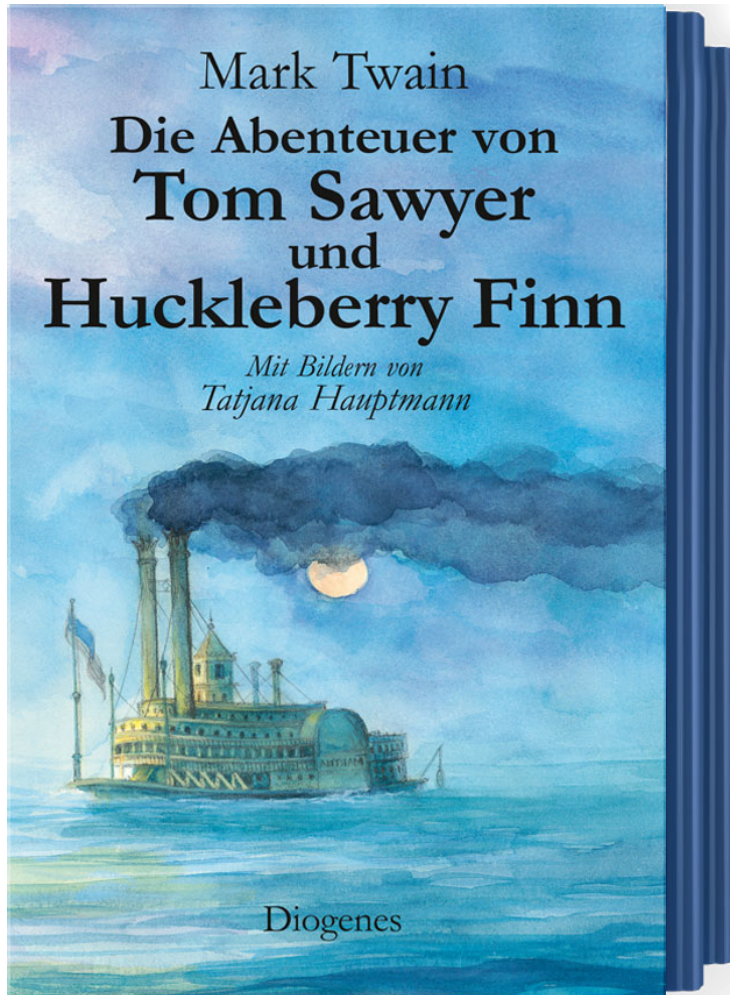

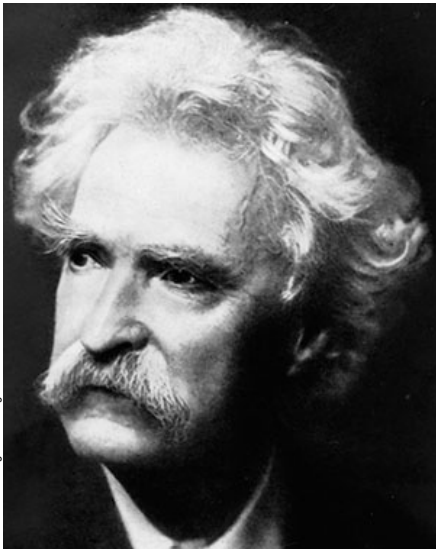

Twain is most noted for his novels ›Adventures of Huckleberry Finn‹, which has since been called the Great American Novel, and ›The Adventures of Tom Sawyer‹.

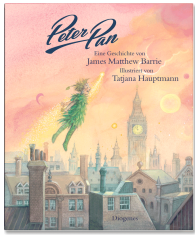

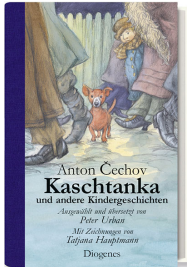
