

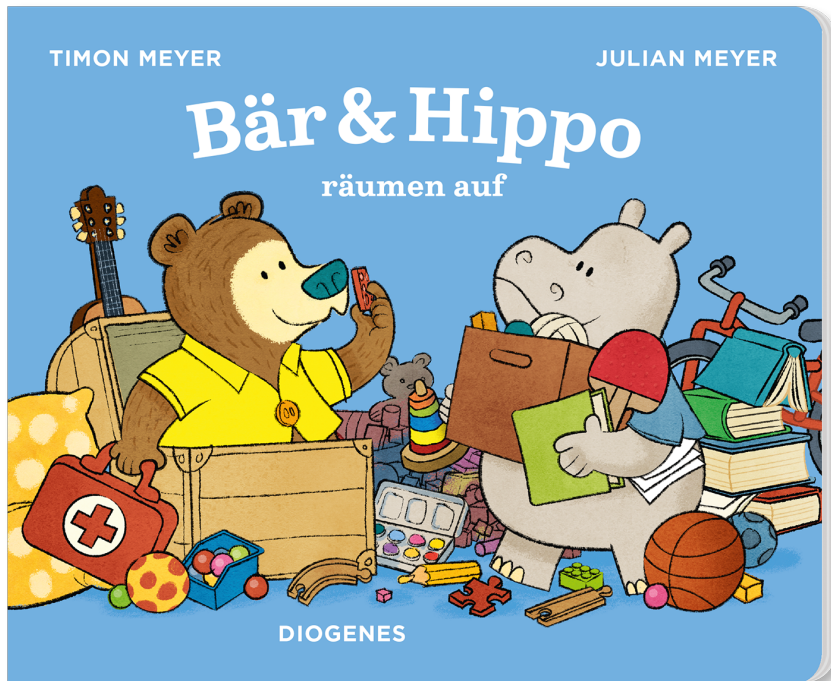

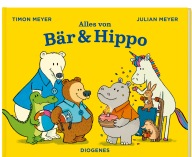

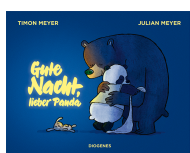

Timon Meyer, born near Stuttgart in 1977, is a freelance author and artist who lives with his family in Queens, New York. Above all else, he loves writing for children.



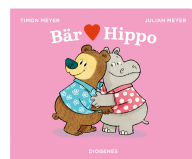

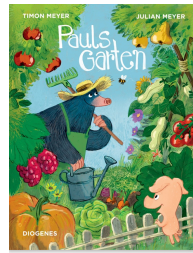

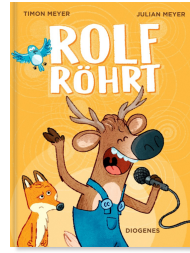
